FACULTY EMERITUS STATUS

Recognition of emeritus faculty shall include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following privileges, benefits, and courtesies:

- 1. An official document which certifies emeritus status of the respective faculty member endorsed by the president of the Governing Board, the Superintendent/President, and the Academic Senate president;
- 2. Listing in all appropriate college publications;
- 3. An identification card which indicates emeritus status at Mendocino College:
- 4. Participation, by choice of the individual, and invitation of the district, in the college's public ceremonies;
- 5. The opportunity to make periodic visits to classes subject to the availability of space and the consent of the class instructor;
- 6. Library and Learning Center privileges comparable to those of the current faculty subject to District policy and administrative regulations;
- 7. Eligibility to serve in an advisory capacity to senate or district committees at the invitation of the appropriate committee chair;
- 8. Eligibility to participate in campus-based professional development activities;
- 9. Use of the physical fitness lab during its regular hours.
