STUDENT GOVERNMENT

The Board of Trustees of Mendocino-lake Community College District encourages students to form their own government to represent the students at the College and conduct activities not in conflict with the authority and responsibility of the District.

The Vice President of Education and Student Services and the Dean of Student Services will develop the appropriate rules and regulations to support the activities of the student government.

The student government must conduct all activities, including financial operations, in accordance with Board Policy, Administrative Regulations, and applicable Ed Codes.

The student government of Mendocino College is recognized as the official voice for the students in District decision-making processes.

The Board of Trustees shall approve the constitution of the student government. Following initial approval, the constitution will be presented to the Board for approval when revisions are made.
