Disaster/Legal Assistance

FEMA/County/Multi-Agency Local Assistance Center is located in Room 6620 on East end of Mendocino College, Ukiah

AND at the Community Center in Clearlake at 3245 Bowers Ave.

- **Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA):** homeowners/renters/business owners in Lake, Mendocino, Butte, Napa, Sonoma, Yuba Counties. Relief may include grants for temporary housing, home repairs, uninsured and underinsured personal property losses, serious disaster-related needs not covered by insurance.

 - Address of damaged primary residence
 - Description of the damage
 - Information about insurance coverage
 - Current contact telephone number
 - Address where they can receive mail

Support for Mendocino College Victims of Fire

Below is a list of services immediately available to students:

- Bathrooms & Showers: Mendocino College Ukiah Campus bathroom and shower facilities in the Athletic Building are open for public use 24 hours a day. Bathrooms and showers are available. Towels, shampoo, soap, and other hygiene items are provided.
- Food Pantry: Non-perishable food items are free of charge to any current student. Items are available now at the Ukiah Campus (ASMC/Lowery Student Center) and at the North County Center (Willits).
- Food Voucher: A limited number of food vouchers are available to students with an address in the areas impacted by the fires in our region (Potter Valley, Redwood Valley, Clearlake Oaks, Clearlake, and Geyserville). Identification must be presented when claiming the food voucher. Food vouchers may be used for the purchase of any food items at select grocery stores. Food vouchers are available at the North County Center (Willits) and at the Ukiah Campus (MacMillan Hall, 1020 – Vice President, Student Services)
- Emergency Funds: Mendocino College faculty, staff and community members have made emergency funds available to students impacted by the evacuations.
