

What is EOPS?

Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) is a state-funded program that assists eligible students in pursuit of their goal of a college degree, certificate, or transfer to a university.

What does EOPS offer?

EOPS offers assistance with textbooks, assistance with required materials, grants, tutoring, specialized counseling, Priority Registration, and more!

Who is eligible for EOPS?

To receive assistance from EOPS, a student must:

- be a California resident or AB-540 student
- be eligible for a California College Promise Grant (Method A or B)
- enroll full-time (some students enrolled part-time may be eligible for a waiver of this requirement)
- have not completed more than 60 degree applicable college credits
- meet one or more qualifying educational standards (did not graduate from high school, did not place in college level English and/or math, did not graduate high school with at least a 2.50 grade point average, previously enrolled in remedial courses, foster youth, or first generation college student)

How do students apply for EOPS?

Your EOPS Application cannot be processed until all of the following have been done.

STEP 1 - Complete a Mendocino College Admissions Application

There is no need to complete a new Admissions Application if you are already a student at Mendocino College.

STEP 2 - Activate your Mendocino College Issued Email Account

All Mendocino College students have been issued a student email account through Gmail. To activate your student email visit the Mendocino College Portal for instructions. Expect notification via college email from EOPS regarding the status of your EOPS application and EOPS correspondence.

STEP 3 - Submit Income Information

Go to <u>https://fafsa.ed.gov</u> and complete a 2019-20 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA); or a Dream Act Application at <u>https://dream.csac.ca.gov</u>/ (if you are an AB-540 student).

STEP 4 – Submit Academic Transcripts from other colleges attended

Submit a copy of your college transcript from each college you have attended (other than Mendocino College) since high school. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.

STEP 5 – Complete an EOPS Application

Once your EOPS Application is processed, your eligibility status will be posted to your WebAdvisor. Check "My pocuments" in the "Communication" section of your WebAdvisor.
