



Mendocino College Math Class Choices

Mendocino College uses a multiple measures placement process to help you choose the math class that is best for you based on both your experience and your degree pathway.

Level 1 courses: Last class ≥ 10 years ago or no Algebra With a multiple-measures assessment, you may be able to opt-out of corequisite requirements.	Any GPA MTH 80 + corequisite support	Any GPA Math 79 or MTH 178 + Math Lab
Level 2 courses: Any Algebra, Geometry, or Integrated Math I and/or II With a multiple-measures assessment, you may be able to opt-out of corequisite requirements.	Any GPA MTH 80 + corequisite support A/B in either College-prep Alg. I, Geometry, or Integrated Math II Math 80	Any GPA MTH 79 or MTH 178 + Math Lab GPA ≥ 2.8 MTH 178 or MTH 220 + corequisite support
Level 3 courses: Algebra II Integrated Math III	GPA ≥ 3.2 or A/B in last math course completed MTH 121 (STEM) MTH 220 or 230 (Business) GPA < 3.2 MTH 80* (STEM) or MTH 220* *corequisite support recommended	GPA ≥ 3.2 or A/B in course MTH 178 or MTH 220 GPA < 3.2 MTH 178 or MTH 220* *corequisite support or math lab recommended
Level 4 courses: Trigonometry Precalculus or higher If you passed a higher level math course with an A/B or an AP exam with a score ≥ 3 , you may be eligible for higher STEM placement with a multiple-measures assessment.	GPA ≥ 3.0 or A/B in last math course completed MTH 200 (STEM) MTH 220 or 230 (Business) GPA < 3.0 MTH 121 (STEM) MTH 220 or 230 (Business)	Any GPA MTH 178 or MTH 220

Students who wish to place higher than the default placement may take an additional multiple measures assessment. It is recommended that students majoring in Business Administration for Transfer take MTH 220 before taking MTH 230.
