

PART-TIME COMPUTER SCIENCE/INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INSTRUCTOR(S)

Mendocino College is currently accepting applications for a part-time computer science and/or information technology instructor at the Ukiah campus. Please contact David Pai (dpai@mendocino.edu) with any questions regarding the classes.

DUTIES: Duties of part-time instructors include: all assigned teaching hours; preparing classroom presentations and assignments; evaluating student performances including quizzes, comprehensive examinations, term papers, projects, and laboratory experiments; supervision of classes; availability for consultation with students; staying current with developments in their respective fields.

POTENTIAL COURSES: Areas of teaching interest include, but are not limited to, teaching Linux, Computer Hardware and Software, Networking, Network Security, Web Design, Mobile Application Development, Programming (Python, Java, C++), Database Systems, Computer Organization and Architecture, and Discrete Structures.

QUALIFICATIONS: The minimum qualifications for a part-time Information Technology Instructor are *any bachelor's degree or higher and two years experience, or any associate degree and six years of professional experience*. Professional experience is required when the applicant possesses a master's degree. The professional experience required must be directly related to the information technology teaching assignment.

The minimum qualifications for a part-time Computer Science Instructor are a master's degree in Computer Science or a closely related field.

ASSIGNMENT/SALARY: Assignments are made on a part-time, hourly contract basis. A part-time teaching assignment may not exceed a total of 67% of an annual full-time assignment. Salary is determined by the total class hours times the individual's hourly rate of pay.
