Mendocino College uses a multiple measures placement process to help you choose the math class that is best for you based on both your experience and your degree pathway.

<p>Level 2 courses: Any Algebra, Geometry, or Integrated Math I and/or II</p> <p>With a multiple-measures assessment, you may be able to opt-out of corequisite requirements.</p>	<p><b>Any GPA</b> MTH 80 + corequisite support</p> <p><b>A/B in either College-prep Alg. I, Geometry, or Integrated Math II</b> Math 80</p>	<p><b>Any GPA</b> MTH 79 or MTH 178 + Math Lab</p> <p><b>GPA <math>\geq</math> 2.8</b> MTH 178 or MTH 220 + corequisite support</p>
<p>Level 3 courses: Algebra II Integrated Math III</p>	<p><b>GPA <math>\geq</math> 3.2 or</b> <b>A/B in last math course completed</b> MTH 121 (STEM) MTH 220 or 230 (Business)</p> <p><b>GPA <math>&lt;</math> 3.2</b> MTH 80* (STEM) or MTH 220* *corequisite support recommended</p>	<p><b>GPA <math>\geq</math> 3.2 or A/B in course</b> MTH 178 or MTH 220</p> <p><b>GPA <math>&lt;</math> 3.2</b> MTH 178 or MTH 220* *corequisite support or math lab recommended</p>
<p>Level 4 courses: Trigonometry Precalculus or higher</p> <p>If you passed a higher level math course with an A/B or an AP exam with a score <math>\geq</math> 3, you may be eligible for higher STEM placement with a multiple-measures assessment.</p>	<p><b>GPA <math>\geq</math> 3.0 or</b> <b>A/B in last math course completed</b> MTH 200 (STEM) MTH 220 or 230 (Business)</p> <p><b>GPA <math>&lt;</math> 3.0</b> MTH 121 (STEM) MTH 220 or 230 (Business)</p>	<p><b>Any GPA</b> MTH 178 or MTH 220</p>

Students who wish to place higher than the default placement may take an additional multiple measures assessment. It is recommended that students majoring in Business Administration for Transfer take MTH 220 before taking MTH 230.
