### Financial Aid

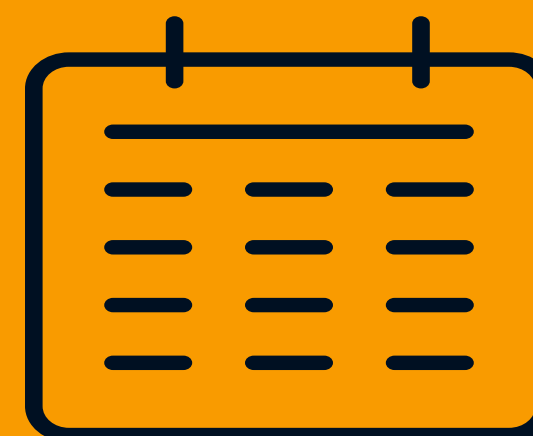
When checking your **MyMendo** account, review your financial aid status. If needed, chat with a Financial Aid Technician.
